

## **Beware ! Automated Phone Message Attack**

Pre-recorded phone messages are being delivered to random consumers with the warning that their debit cards have been closed. When the consumers call the telephone number provided by the fraudsters they hear a recording that requests a 16-digit card number and PIN. Please do not call these numbers, they may still be active. The matter is under investigation by the U.S. Secret Service.
